

Cost of Attendance Budgets

Douglas J Aveda Institute creates student cost of attendance (COA) budgets for awarding financial aid. Cost of attendance budgets include institutional charges such as tuition, fees, kit, books, and supplies and non-institutional charges such as room and board, miscellaneous personal expenses, transportation, etc.

The cost of attendance is a student’s cost for the period for which the aid is intended. Typically the loan period and associated cost of attendance is related to the first 900 clock hours, the balance of the program, or the entire program length for programs less than 900 clock hours. The cost of attendance used for Pell Grants is always the full-year costs for a full-time student.

In general, a student’s cost of attendance is the sum of the following:

- Tuition
- Fees
- Kit Allowance, including books, course materials, equipment, and supplies
- Food and Housing Allowance
- Transportation Allowance
- Miscellaneous Personal Expenses Allowance

Other cost of attendance allowances may be included at the Institute’s discretion and/or student’s request and eligibility, including dependent care, disability, etc.

The information below is used to construct student cost of attendance budgets during the 2023 - 2024 award year in the state of Michigan.
